

Oak Meadow Sample Lesson

Spanish 4, Lessons 35 and 36

For your final 2 lessons of this course, choose 1 of the following 2 topics. Develop your thoughts and comments in Spanish on 3 typed pages (+ -), using various verb forms to demonstrate your knowledge of grammar and the verb tenses.

A) Summarize and explain what you appreciated and enjoyed in your study of Spanish over the past 4 years. Perhaps you have particular Spanish speaking countries that you would like to visit one day. Maybe there are aspects of Spanish cultures that you have related to or found most interesting, such as food, music, art or customs. Explain how and why you are able to connect with these values of another culture.

You may add pictures or graphics to highlight your thoughts.

B) Write a short story in Spanish. It may be descriptive or fictitious. You may create your own them, or base your story on something you have read in Spanish, or a Spanish speaking person that you have met or have come to know.

Your story should reflect in some way traits, beliefs, legends or values that would be particular to Spanish.
