

# Academic Planning Worksheet

For students who plan to graduate high school with Oak Meadow, we require a distribution of academic credits that will provide a comprehensive education and a well-rounded transcript for college entrance requirements.

**A minimum of 22 credits is required to qualify for a diploma: a full year course is a 10 month course and equals one credit, a semester course is a five month course and equals half a credit (0.5).**
